- (d) personal property that the Member, the Member's spouse or adult interdependent partner or one of the Member's family uses primarily for transportation, household, educational, recreational, social or aesthetic purposes;
- (e) unpaid taxes, except property taxes under the Municipal Government Act and taxes under the School Act; and
- (f) support obligations.
